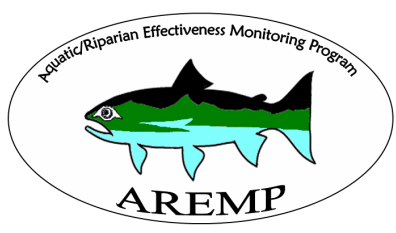

### The Program:

The Aquatic and Riparian Effectiveness Monitoring Program (AREMP) determines present watershed condition based on upslope, riparian, and in-channel attributes, tracks trends in watershed condition over time, and reports on the Northwest Forest Plan's (NWFP) effectiveness across the region. Every summer we hire field crews to travel all over the Northwest Forest Plan area to collect stream habitat and channel mapping, water quality, macro-invertebrate and amphibian data.

### The Position:

AREMP is planning on filling one GS-0482-09 Lead Fish Biologist TERM position. The incumbent will serve as the Lead Field Coordinator for AREMP. This person will be responsible for assisting with annually implementing the field component of AREMP as well as assisting the Field Operations Supervisor with activities relevant to the future direction of the program. The incumbent may interact with various agency representatives, managers, and scientists for the purpose of effectively implementing AREMP within the NWFP area. As the Lead Field Coordinator the incumbent will have oversight of some technical and administrative aspects of the field sampling efforts such as budgeting, staffing, training, permitting, sampling, data management, data quality, logistics and safety.

The incumbent will spend a lot of time in the field during the field season (April—September) to help train crews and ensure high quality data is collected. This requires weekly travel within the NWFP area, from northern California to the Washington British Columbia Border on the west side of the Cascade mountains to work with field crews. Crews work an 8 days on, 6 days off work schedule from Wednesday to Wednesday during the field season.

### The Duty Station:

The incumbent is assigned to the Oregon State Office of the Bureau of Land Management Branch of Planning, Science and Resource Information. The duty station for this position is Corvallis, Oregon at the Siuslaw National Forest Supervisors Office where the AREMP Core Team is stationed.

Corvallis is centrally located in the Willamette Valley, 90 miles southwest of Portland, 35 miles south of Oregon's capitol city of Salem, and about 40 miles north of Eugene. It has a population of 50,000 and receives approximately 40 inches of annual precipitation in a mild climate. Corvallis is a college town, home of Oregon State University, that offers big town amenities while still maintaining a small town atmosphere. The Pacific Ocean and world-renowned shoreline is an hour drive from Corvallis. It is a full service community with elementary and high schools, shopping, restaurants, and churches. Linn-Benton Community College is located 10 miles east of Corvallis and Eugene is home to the University of Oregon. Corvallis is known for its strong recycling program.
