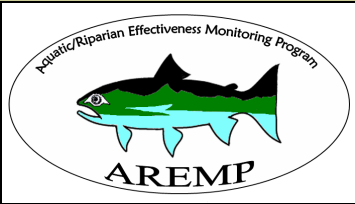

Seasonal Term Crew Leaders

- AREMP is hiring **four** seasonal term Crew Leaders as GS-0404-06 Biological Science Technicians.
- These positions guarantee at least six months of work each year from approximately April to September.
- These are primarily field-going positions. During the field season, crews camp in remote locations and work for 8 days in a row.
- Some of the duties for this position include:
 - Provides leadership for a crew of 3 or more additional members.
 - Uses commonly accepted fisheries and hydrologic techniques to collect field data including, but not limited to: surveying channel profiles, tallying wood occurrences, using electronic water chemistry meters, measuring substrate dimensions, collecting macroinvertebrate samples, and conducting amphibian surveys.

Term Technical Assistant

- AREMP is hiring **one** term Technical Assistant as a GS-0404-06 Biological Science Technician.
- This is a full time, year-round position.
- The incumbent will spend the majority of his/her time working in the office with limited time spent conducting field work.
- Some of the duties for this position include:
 - Maintenance, calibration, and repair of electronic equipment.
 - Manages equipment cleanup, inventory, and repair after the field season is complete.
 - Keeps the AREMP vehicle fleet in working order.
 - Coordinates the use, maintenance, and procurement of communications devices (cell phones, radios, satellite phones, etc.).

All term positions are eligible for health benefits. Term positions are renewed on an annual basis, for up to four years total, depending on both budget and program needs.
