**Responsibilities:**

This position will have three focal areas;

1. Conduct biological and project sampling within the John Day Basin to be used for management decision making and biological assessments.
2. Provide assistance with the Tribes established habitat and watershed restoration program with input on project design for aquatic species.
3. Development of a study design to support ongoing project evaluation and effectiveness monitoring.

The position will also be responsible for grant writing to further the development of this portion of the program.

**Qualifications:**

A bachelor's degree in fisheries or related field plus at least 3 years of experience conducting biological sampling, ecological monitoring. Familiarity with Pacific Northwest salmonids their habitats, and restoration techniques. Ability to work in the field and office with minimal supervision, and experience with program development and grant writing.
