The Brush Creek-Hayden, Laramie and Douglas Ranger Districts, Medicine Bow-Routt National Forests, are planning to fill one GS-0482-9/11, Fisheries Biologist position. The position will be permanent full time, with a duty station at the Brush Creek-Hayden Ranger District located in Saratoga, WY. Government housing is not available. This north zone position will be responsible for the fisheries program management on the Brush Creek Hayden, Laramie and Douglas Ranger Districts of the Medicine Bow National Forest and the Thunder Basin National Grassland.

POSITION INFORMATION:

The incumbent serves as the fishery biologist for field activities, responsible for coordinating the program and providing leadership in fishery and amphibian resource management with other district resource areas. Other resource areas include timber, silviculture, stewardship fuels, roads and trails, recreation, special uses, range, minerals, wildlife, watershed restoration, and facilities. The three ranger districts have an established fisheries and watershed restoration programs focusing on Colorado River Cutthroat trout fish habitat. This position is a member of the primary staff, reporting directly to the Brush Creek Hayden District Ranger.

The Forest is looking for a highly motivated, career oriented individual for this position.

During the application process within AVUE, applicants need be sure to select "**Saratoga, WY**" from the "**Preferred Location**" screen within the "**Applicant Information**" page.
