Field Tour – Pelton Round Butte Selective Water Withdrawal Friday, March 3rd

Portland General Electric and the Confederated Tribes of Warm Springs invite you to join us for a tour of the Pelton Round Butte Selective Water Withdrawal juvenile fish passage facilities (SWW). The SWW re-establishes the connection for anadromous steelhead, Chinook and sockeye between the ocean and 250 stream miles of habitat in the upper Deschutes basin. Annually, we collect between 37,000 and 262,000 smolts at the SWW transporting them to the lower Deschutes River to continue their downstream migration.



Come see this one of a kind facility, learn about our fish collection, processing, efficiency studies and plans for the future.
